

Sample Treasure Hunt

First Clue - Intricate means involved, complicated, or difficult. God created this world with a very intricate design. Find this word in your dictionary and you will find the first clue.

(Intricate was one of Danielle's vocabulary words this week. You can pick any word your child is studying.)

Second Clue

"All things bright and beautiful,
All creatures, great and small,
All things wise and wonderful,
The Lord God made them all.
Each little flower that opens,
Each little bird that sings,
He made their glowing colors,
He made their tiny wings."

You will find the clue in the 6th line . (We use "Christian Kids Explore Biology" by Stephanie L. Redmond. The first lesson had this poem by Cecil Frances Alexander so I used it for clues. We have a bird so Danielle would know to look in the bird cage to find the next clue.)

Third Clue

"The purple-headed mountain,
The river running by,
The sunset and the morning,
That brightens up the sky;
The cold wind in the winter,
The pleasant summer sun,
The ripe fruits in the garden –
He made them every one. "

You will find the next clue in the $15 - 8 = \underline{\quad}$ line.

(Danielle would count to line 7 and go to the garden to look for the next clue. We are reviewing subtraction math facts this week so I used them in this treasure hunt. You can use any type of math problems depending on what your child is studying that week.)

Fourth Clue

"The tall trees in the greenwood,
The meadows where we play,
The rushes by the water
We gather every day ---"

You will find the next clue in $9 - 6 = \underline{\quad}$ line.

(Danielle would go to find the next clue in the bushes by our pond.)
